# The Job

C Wood & Son Luton Ltd were contracted to strip out and re-build a timber ramp, which allows access to an outdoor classroom, at Thomas Whitehead Academy. The timber was rotting away and the ramp became unsafe for the children and staff to use.

We first took down and removed the existing timber ramp at the entrance of the classroom so we could start fresh and disposed of the rotting timber.

New timber posts were installed to form the new structure of the ramp and was soon followed by the new stringers.

Anti-slip decking was put down for precaution measures and balustrading was put up also.

The school were very happy with the final result and contracted us to finish an existing concrete ramp on site along with quoting for some other works too.



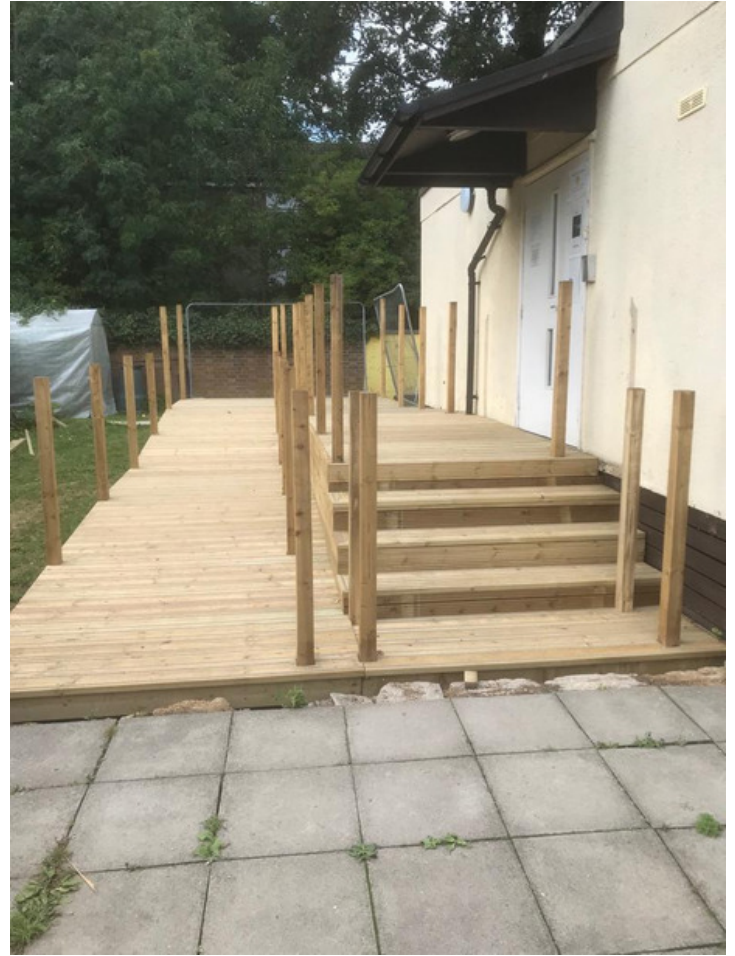
