Mezzanine Floor
Watford

The Job

Watford Workshops contracted us for the installation of a mezzanine floor to be incorporated within their office space above the working factory floor.

We began working at night to install the steel frame so as not to disturb the workers with the loud installation. Once completed, we began working during the day and started with constructing the 3No offices to the top of the mezzanine. Access was created via a staircase to the front and a lift was installed to accommodate 1No wheelchair as well as an operator. We supplied and installed the suspended ceilings, incorporating 600x600mm LED panel lights to the offices and landing area. The electrical and data points were installed in dado trunking, the partition walls were decorated in a modern grey with contrasting grey carpet tiles and the underside of the mezzanine was clad with fire protection to ensure a minimum of 30 minutes (to comply with building regulation). Whilst working we tried to keep minimal impact on the working stations below to ensure an enjoyable working environment for everyone.

The clients were over the moon with the finished result and was officially opened on January 23rd by Lord-Lieutenant of Hertfordshire.
