> Case Study



The Job

C Wood and Son were employed to build an extension to a church in Luton with various other works.

- Erected a scaffold to the rear and left
- · side of the church to the flat roof and
- gable.
- Stripped 2 rows of tile back from verge.
- and set aside for re-use.
- Removed the undercloak/tiles, plastic clad barge board soffit and rotten timber.
- Stripped back the flat roof with rotten soffit and fascia.
- Re-decked the flat roof in OSB3 including all tiling fillets and cant rails, new barge and verge.
- Took down the existing front porch.
- Dug the footings, concreted and
- brought the brickwork up to DPC,
- insulated and capped oversite.
- Moved the external drain.
- Constructed new walls and piers.
- Formed new green roof.
- Disconnected the WC to the upstairs.
- Cut a new doorway into the office and fit the new door frame and ironmongery.
- Supplied and fitted new skirtings, architraves, toilet and basin.
- Screeded the floors and supplied and installed new radiator.
- Completed all electrical and plumbing work.
- Installed new vinyl to WC and carpet tiles to the store room.
- Repaired the concrete cills, portal frame, telltale with epoxy and eves.
- Carried out all decoration, stained the brickwork and installed glazed fire door.
- Supplied and installed 4 posts and chains to the front of the extension.
