The Job

C Wood & Son Luton

Ltd removed the crysotile cladding from the cowshed and stripped the remaining materials.

The footings were concreted and a dwarf wall was built to support the timber frame super structure. All of the original stanchions were incorporated into the external skin and roof, new walls were built to support the internal steels that were to take the first floor once the timber structure was complete.

It was insulated using paverflex insulation and isolair board and the exterior was clad with traditional feather board cladding.

Electrics and plumbing were installed as well as roof sheets and windows.

The plastering was competed to a high standard, despite the curved ceilings, and the carpentry and door fittings and top spec kitchen followed suit.

All details such as decorating were finished last and the property was left in the highest standard.
