## The Job

C. Wood & Son were employed by a client in Luton to undertake a kitchen refurbishment at their property.


- Opened up to check for steel above arches
- Stripped out the kitchen, hacked off tiles and lifted the flooring
  - Removed the ceiling in kitchen and dining room
  - Removed the back door and window
  - Removed the brickwork to centralise door and bricked up to form new opening.
  - Supported the wall, removed the internal arch wall and installed steel
  - Installed drainage for new layout WC, basin and washing machine
  - Installed new UPVC back door
  - Installed new 3no UPVC windows
  - Plied the floor
  - Moved the boiler and altered the pipework to suit new layout
  - Installed new radiator
  - Installed studwork to form utility and WC, insulated and plaster boarded
  - To plasterboard and skim ceilings
  - Skimmed all the walls
  - Tiled the floor
  - Installed 2no internal doors and frames
  - Installed kitchen and utility
  - Tiled splash back to worktops
  - Installed 4no shelves to under stair cupboard
  - Supplied and installed WC and basin

## The Job

- Installed electrics:
- 10no double sockets
- 5no spurs
- 5no single sockets
- 8no downlights with two way switch
- 2no downlights with two way switch
- 2no downlights with switch
- 2no fans
- 1no cooker point
  - Installed skirting
  - Primed, applied undercoat and gloss to woodwork
  - Applied 1no mist coat and 2no coats of emulsion to walls and ceiling
