> Case Study



The Job

C. Wood & Son were employed by Central Bedfordshire Council to to carry out a disabled adaptations project for a family in Totternhoe, Bedfordshire.

One member of the family particularly struggles with her mobility and found the steep steps and small uneven path that lead up to the house, difficult to manage.



For this project we:

- Took up the existing concrete path and front garden.
- Removed the two steps outside the front door.
- Removed the existing handrails that were either side of the two steps outside the front door.
- Installed drainage to accommodate new driveway.
- Laid MOT and sharp sand before the new block paving driveway in the excavated area.
- Laid 3 rectangular shaped steps 800mmx1000mm wide leading up to the front door.
- Reinstalled handrails either side of the new steps.

This project was completed in 1 week and both the council and family were delighted with the finished result.
