> Case Study



The Job

C. Wood & Son were employed by a family in Luton, Bedfordshire, to carry out their kitchen refurbishment project.

For this project we:

- Installed temporary sheeting to opening in the hall and stripped out kitchen to save
 - Stripped out and dispose of the Salon and WC
 - Lifted the flooring to Salon, removed ceilings and disposed of
 - Dug out and concreted pad for 1No pier
 - Adjusted floor joists and installed Padstones ready for steels, followed by the steels as per Structural Engineers report.
 - Installed underground drainage to suit new layout
 - Bricked up the existing window in the old utility, bricked up the garage window and took out the back door, and dispose of
 - Toothed out brickwork and installed lintel for new larger opening
 - Laid membrane, insulation and screed
 - Built stud walls to form new layout of the refurb, insulated and plaster boarded both sides
 - Installed plumbing ready for new kitchen, WC and utitlity followed by installation of WC, basin and 3no radiators
 - Plaster boarded the ceilings and skimmed, plus skimming all the walls
 - Installed 3no Glazed doors, frames and skirting
 - Applied 1no mist and 2no coats of emulsion to walls and
 - ceilings, knotted, primed, undercoated and glossed all woodwork
 - Took down hall ceiling, followed by plasterboard and skimming
 - Finished by decorating the hall walls and ceiling

This project was a big one but the finished result looks incredible.
