

## The Job

C. Wood & Son were employed by a family to carry out some external decoration works to their 16th Century cottage in Tempsford, Bedfordshire.

The family were told by their conservation representative, that they needed to use paint to match the current faded colour of the property, and not the original pink that was used. So we had to take this into account when doing the decoration works.

## For this project we:

- Erected scaffolding to the left hand elevation for access
- Replaced the blown bricks
- Raked out and repointed the wall ready for decoration.
- Erected tower scaffolds to the remainder of the property and sheeted up the floor
- Took samples of the existing paint to source paint match
- Prepared render panels ready for decoration
- Applied 2No coats of Dulux Weathershield Masonry Paint
- Applied 2N coats of Osmo Clear Wood Stain to the oak beams
- Cleared site on completion

Our client was delighted with the final finish and have already asked us to quote for some more works on their land!
